Mrs. Nickolette Way, age 58, died at UCLA Medical Center in Los Angeles, CA, on Friday, February 5, 2010 due to heart failure.

Born January 29, 1952, in Glendale, CA, she lived most of her life in Southern California. She studied at La Sierra University and Pacific Union College. She met her beloved husband, Chuckie, in Korea while she was teaching English. Nickolette worked on behalf of her family, her friends, carcinoid cancer, and the church.

Nickolette was diagnosed with viral myocarditis in 1996. In 1998 it was discovered that the heart damage was caused by Carcinoid Cancer. She worked endlessly to understand her disease and to help others understand their disease. In 2001 she started the SEA4Carcinoid support group to help others struggling with this little known disease. The emphasis of this support group was education for the patients and healthcare professionals. Her efforts greatly impacted the carcinoid cancer world.

Nickolette was vibrant with an amazing love of life. Although she was inhibited by her disease, she never let it slow her down. She was not able to do all the athletic endeavors she had enjoyed in her early years; however, she filled her life with so many new endeavors it was difficult to tell she had slowed down at all. Her passion after her diagnosis was to share her knowledge of Carcinoid Cancer with everyone, helping as many people as she could.
